The Director is responsible for oversight of Las Vegas Social Service programs and services. These provide a continuum of care for people who are poor and homeless or who are in danger of being homeless and low income clients who need services provided by The Salvation Army.

Qualified Candidates must have:

- MSW plus a minimum of five years experience in administration of \$1M plus social service programs serving the poor and homeless and/or similar education and experience. This includes understanding the problems and needs of the poor and homeless, the government and other programs available to assist them, how to overcome barriers to finding a stable home, and how to determine those who would benefit most from programs.
- Extensive knowledge of the target population and applicable Salvation Army policies and procedures preferred.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
- Computer literate in MS Word, Excel, and TSA Social Service software
